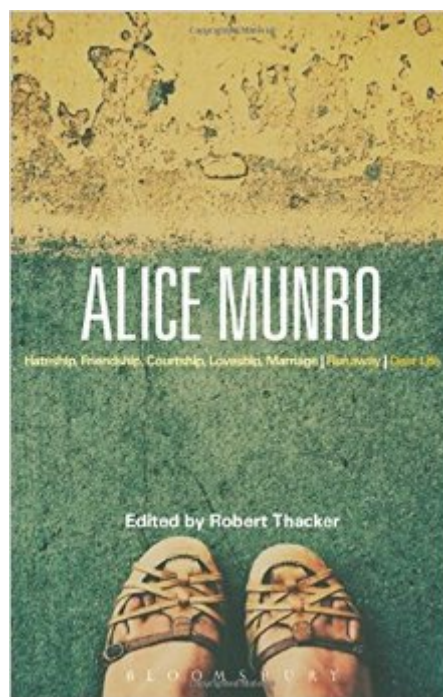

In these three late collections Munro sharply articulates, again and again, the mysteries of being itself.
