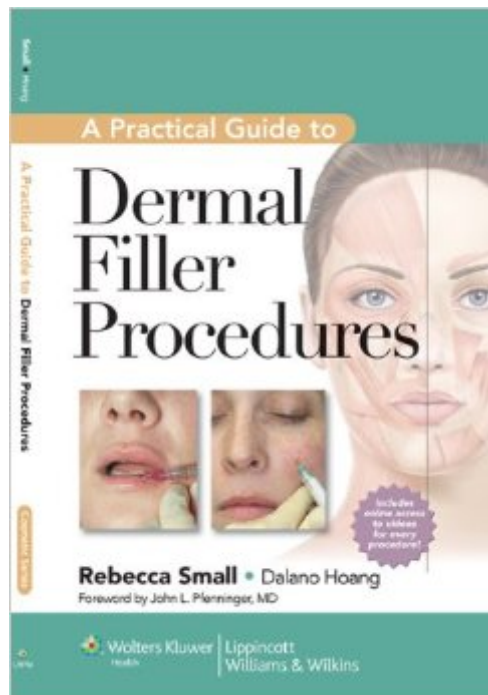

This is reasonably good practical guide for beginners. The information provided is very limited. For example, differences between different types of Juvederm is not discussed. Video clips of the

procedures available on the internet are very limited and don't give any specific information of how much of the product was used. Only some of the procedures are available on the internet. Descriptions of some of the anesthesia procedures are included in the book, but not demonstrated on the video clips. I would recommend this book for someone who wants to start doing dermal filler procedures and needs to know the basics.

Dr. Small has written another great book in her Practical Guide Series. Dr. Small's experience with teaching shines through. The book is clearly written and well organized and describes clearly the anatomy of the face, anesthesia for the procedures, the how-to of injection, complications and contraindications. There are good photographs and illustrations and the book comes with an on-line video showing actual injections. I consider this book a must-have and highly recommend it for any injector of fillers.
