NOTE: For Spanish, **no** changes to **na** before masculine nouns and to **nas** before feminine nouns, **ordinal** agree in gender and number with their nouns. **primero** and **segundo** are used before masculine singular nouns.

DEFINITE ARTICLES
Definite articles indicate a specific person, place, or thing. The Spanish definite articles are **el, los, la, las** (which translate to the in English) and used with:
• Nouns in a series: **Frases de libros, el capítulo 2 of *El Quijote* sobre la mesa.** (I got the book, notebook, and pen on the table.)
• Certain nouns such as **ciudad (city) and escuela (school)**, where English often omits the article: **¿Vas a la escuela?** (Are they going to school?) **Ella va a la escuela.** (She is going to school.)
• Abstract concepts: **La honestidad es una virtud.** (Honesty is a virtue.)
• Nouns of weight or measure: **Las personas crecen un kilo a la hora.** (The person can gain a pound.)
• Titles when used with a name: **La Dra. García tiene 18 años.** (She is 18.)

INDEFINITE ARTICLES
Indefinite articles are **un, una, unos, unas** (which translate to a, an, some, some) and used with:
• Nouns in a series: **Frases de libros, un capítulo 2 of *El Quijote* sobre la mesa.** (I got the book, notebook, and pen on the table.)
• Abstract concepts: **La honestidad es una virtud.** (Honesty is a virtue.)
• Nouns of weight or measure: **Las personas crecen un kilo a la hora.** (The person can gain a pound.)
• Titles when used with a name: **La Dra. García tiene 18 años.** (She is 18.)
