

If you were looking to start your study of American postmodern poetry, this is it. For the most part, the two main movements of American post modern poetry starting in the 1950s consist of the Beat poets including Allen Ginsberg, and many of the poets in the San Francisco scene, and the Black Mountain school poets from Black Mountain college in North Carolina, and their followers with their

leaders being the two main poetry teachers at Black Mountain college, Robert Creeley and Charles Olson. I would recommend this book if you wanted to start reading those poets and their followers and how they affect American poetry today.

This is a great book. A good little collection of the postmoderns, especially if you don't know much about them, you get a good little taste of each of them and their styles. Also has many Black Mountain poets (they are postmodern too). Highly recommended as a good buy, and a great addition to any library.
