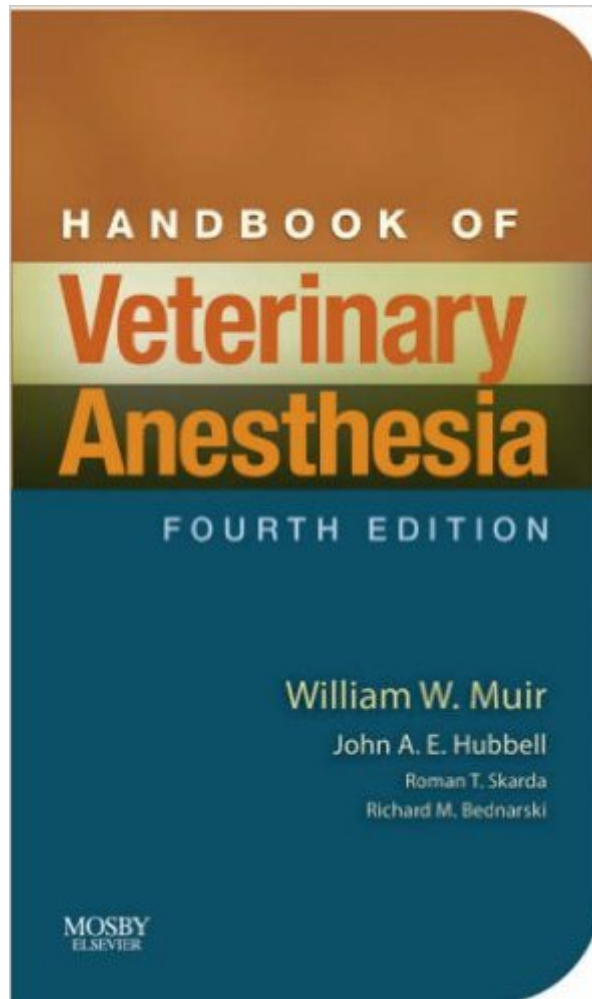

I am a second year veterinary student. My roommate bought the standard anesthesia text-Lumb and Jones and I bought Muir. We both ended up using Muir because it is much more comprehensive at this level than Lumb and Jones (which is an excellent reference but a bit overwhelming for an introductory anesthesia course). In my experience Muir had all the necessary information laid out in an easy to read format, as well as lots of charts which helped to pull everything together.

Overall this is a very well written text on anesthesia in the veterinary field. A fantastic resource both for students and those that have been in practice for many years. It covers the basics like mechanisms of actions of the anesthetic drugs utilized, as well as chapters that focus on pain management in the perioperative period. It doesn't just focus on small animals, either, there are very thorough chapters on large animal anesthesia.
