

Besides that it's cheap for a textbook, I ordered this for my students because it is one of the only handbooks I've seen that lists how to do in-text citations alongside how to do references, as opposed to having these in two separate sections as many handbooks do. It also shows MLA, APA, and CMS (Chicago) formats alongside each other. The advantage to this layout is that a student can look up how to reference, for example, an article in a journal, and all on the same page can see how to do the reference AND in-text citation in 3 different formats. The tips on clarity and concision, etc. in this book are also good.

I used this in a class recently. Bearing in mind that perhaps the hardest thing in the world to teach is good writing, this book seems to have been pretty effective. It inveighs against what Harvey calls the "pompous style," which I find to be common in, and extremely damaging to, much student writing. Moreover, he gives sound, specific suggestions on how to avoid such pomposity. Of course, if you use it in a classroom you'll have to devise ways to make sure the students actually read it. Highly recommended.

The Nuts and Bolts of College Writing is a style guide much in the same vain as Shrunk and White's Element's of Style. Indeed, the two complement each other quite nicely. If you write academically and haven't read Elements of Style and Nuts and Bolts, I highly recommend doing so.
