

Through translation and loving care the author has illuminated the lives and traditions of women that Westerners would normally never meet. The approach of these Egyptians, who have almost nothing, to life, family, children and friendship is a lesson to those of us who are better off. How many of us are like the "Foolish Beetle"? We run around in circles, wasting our energy complaining about how hard life is, how hungry we are. We are so busy being miserable that we miss the juicy grubs in our path or the delicious dung heep that would feed our families for a week. I loved the book.
