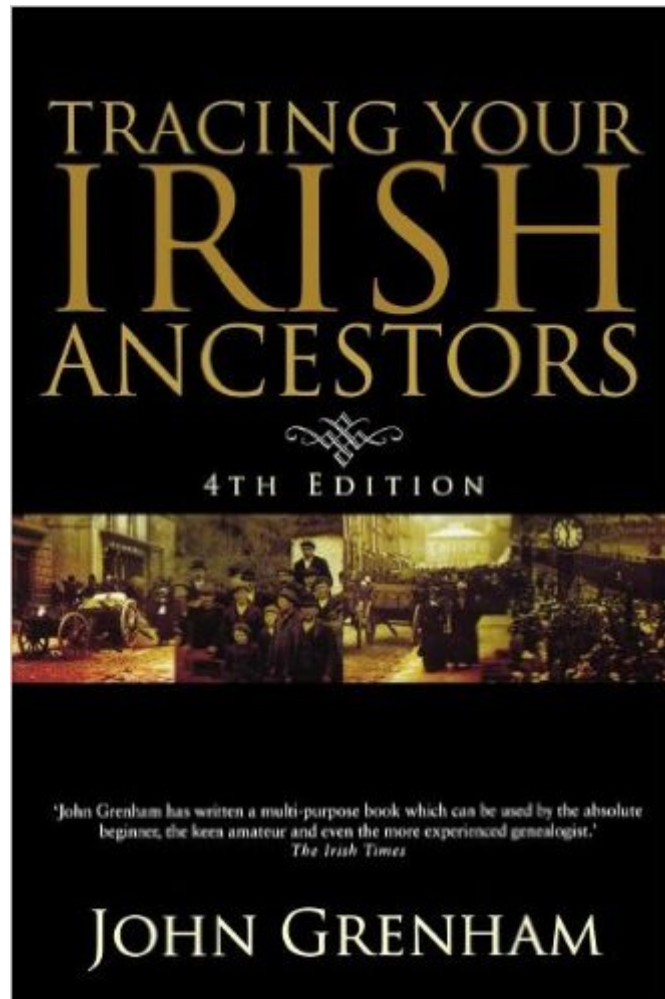

An excellent starting point for anyone doing family history research into Irish origins. Lots of website links recommended and primary sources compared to save guess work - no sense spending hours online only to find the information one is seeking is actually not accessible. Chapter lay-out gives accurate means to target information later and good explanations are offered at every step to help

refine searches. Recommended.

This book will answer questions concerning why certain information cannot be found, or if available were to find it. Also, unlike England's General Registrars Office, Ireland has different offices for Ireland and Northern Ireland. You will find these in this book.
