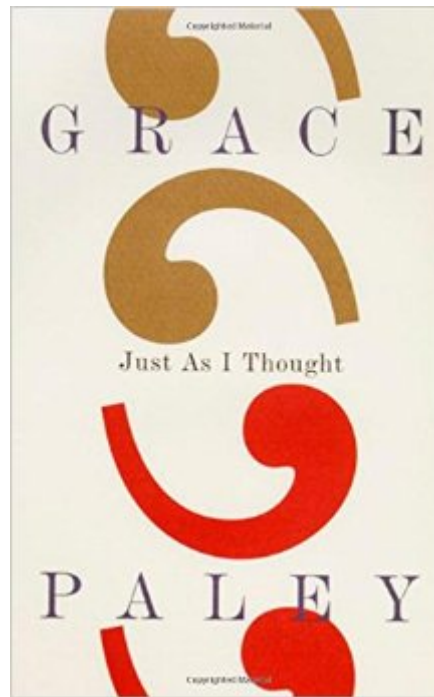

With the same sincerity, frankness and heartfelt commitment she shows in her fiction, Paley shows us a world full of activists, ordinary citizens, cops and politicians.
