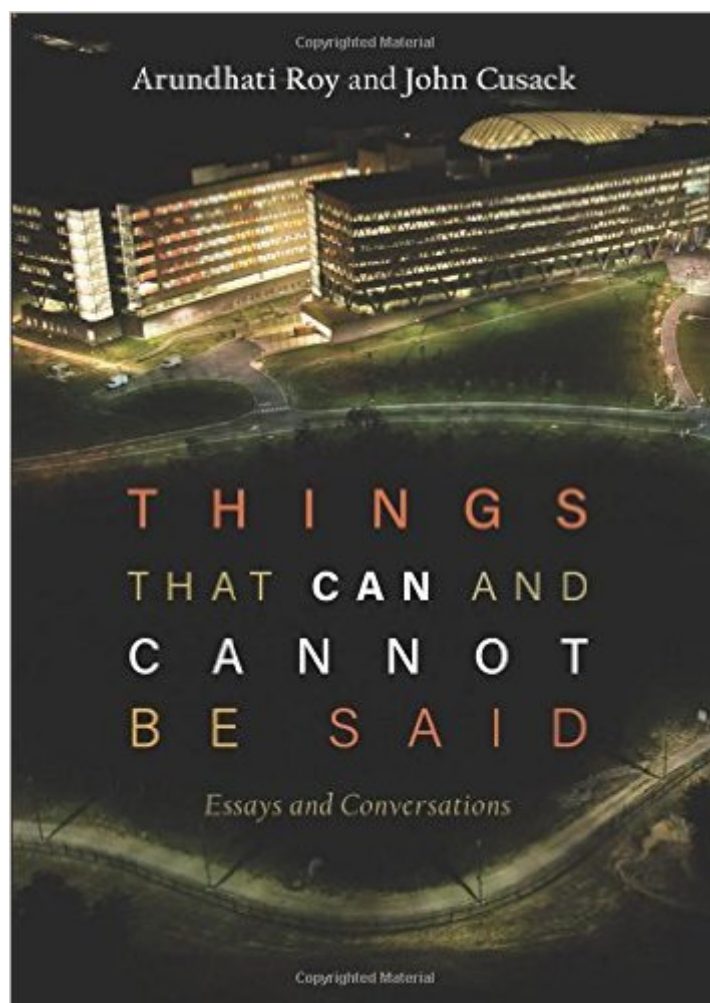

# Things That Can And Cannot Be Said: Essays And Conversations

In late 2014, Arundhati Roy, John Cusack, and Daniel Ellsberg travelled to Moscow to meet with NSA whistleblower Edward Snowden. The result was a series of essays and dialogues in which Roy and Cusack reflect on their conversations with Snowden. Arundhati Roy is a writer and global justice activist. From her celebrated Booker Prize-winning novel *The God of Small Things*, to her prolific output of writing on topics ranging from climate change to war, the perils of free-market "development" in India, and the defense of the poor, Roy's voice has become indispensable to millions seeking a better world. John Cusack is a writer, filmmaker, and a board member of the Freedom of the Press Foundation. He has written the screenplays for the movies *Grosse Pointe Blank*, *High Fidelity*, and *War, Inc.*, with Mark Leyner and Jeremy Pikser, among many others. His writing has appeared widely, including the *Guardian*, *Truthout*, and *Outlook India*.
